After which if there is any funds left they will be equally divided ammongst any of our Family that may survive her.

This I do the 3rd day of April 1894.

Died od Senile Decay at 6.55pm on 11th February 1910, the Funeral took place on Tuesday 15th February, 1910 at 3.00pm from the house to Trinity Cemetary.

Elizabeth Rattray died at 129 Rosemount Place, Aberdeen on Tuesday 18th August, 1914 at 7.30pm. Her funeral took place on Friday 21st August, 1914 at 3.00pm from the house to Trinity Cemetery where she was buried along side her husband Alexander Booth.

JOHN BOOTH.

Attendant in Surgery, Medicine and Midwifery, 1881 - 1932.

" Boothie " was a character remembered by all medical students through more than half a century. the famous tale, " Me and Ashley managed it a' oorsels ", sets him securely beside the old - time " ministers man ". Born in 1854 he entered the University's service in 1881, and until 1832 his forthrightness, his energy and particular knowledge in his own sphere, and the short he made of pretension, endeared him to the men whom he bullied and served. Stories about him are legion :-

I recollect the occasion when along with some others, I went to the Surgery Department at Marshal to look over the " Instruments " - a collection of archaic tools, the uses of which I think Boothie alone knew. I asked him if Sir Ashley Mackintosh and Sir John Marnoch were just bursting with knowledge or as anxious as we were when they came to their finals. Boothie replied: " Ach, Johnnie Marnoch and Ashley Mackintosh used to come to me an' spier " What's and what's that' ; they were just as stupid as ye are yersel."

During an altercation: " Professor, when I tell lies I like to mak' the facts of it."

Just prior to the appointment of a successor to Professor Marnoch, Mr. Wm Anderson was crossing the Quad when Boothie met him and asked " Here, Anderson, are ye gwan tae get the chair? " Mr. Anderson replied, " That remains to be seen; why? " To which Boothie answered, " Weel gin ye get it, I'll hae tae bide on, cause ye dinna ken onything about the diagrams; but gin the ither cheil gets it, weel, he can jiest scutter awa himsel. "

A self - assurance that touches the sublime and that went hand in hand with a very real efficiency.
