

# *Descendants of Alexander Anderson*

## *Generation No. 1*

1. ALEXANDER<sup>1</sup> ANDERSON was born 1702, and died 12 Apr 1772 in Strichen, Aberdeenshire. He married MARGARET KIDD.

Notes for ALEXANDER ANDERSON:

Lived at the Mill of Rathen at the time of the births of his first three children, before moving to Oldmill, Strichen before the birth of his daughter Margaret. The rest of his family were born there.

His origin has not been established, or when he married Margaret Kidd.

Aprile 16th day 1721 Alex'r Anderson in Miln of Rathen had a son baptized called John in presence of the congregation.

He was for some time in Bogensourie, Strichen, and was resident there when he was witness to the baptism of Girzel, daughter of his brother James, who was then in Oldmill. He had settled in Mill of Forrest two years later, when on 20th June 1768 he was witness to the baptism of Lewis, son of James Urquhart, in Technuiry.

Sometime prior to his death he gave up the tenancy of Mill of Forrest, and took a croft at Greens of Strichen, where he died of old age.

He was unmarried and his testament which was dated 21st February 1803, was confirmed by the Commissariat of Aberdeenshire on 5th January 1804.

Being Tuesday the said day, Alexander Anderson in Mill of Rathen had a son baptised Alexander. Witnesses John McCleucin of Calmcultur and John Milne there.

Alexander Anderson was the first of the "LIMEY ANDERSONS". They were so named because of their trade as masons, and their employment at the old lime - kilns of Strichen (now demolished). Born at the Mill of Rathen, he settled in Wardhead of Strichen, about the time of his marriage to Janet McPherson in 1764.

On 27th June 1771 he along with his brother John, was witness to the baptising of George, eldest son of his brother George. On 8th March 1782, he was again witness to the baptism of John, youngest son of his brother George.

According to his brother Johns testament of 1803, hewas dead before 21st February 1803. (Testiment was confirmed by the Commissariat of Aberdeenshire on 5th January 1804).

8. ALEXANDER<sup>3</sup> ANDERSON (*ALEXANDER<sup>2</sup>, ALEXANDER<sup>1</sup>*) was born 01 Dec 1764 in Strichen, Aberdeenshire, and died 07 Mar 1843 in Strichen, Aberdeenshire. He married CHRISTINA PATERSON, daughter of WILLIAM PATERSON and ELIZABETH CRUDEN. She was born 14 Nov 1773 in Strichen, Aberdeenshire.

Notes for ALEXANDER ANDERSON:

He was also named "LIMEY ANDERSON" same as his father because of his occupation as a mason at the lime-kilns of Strichen. He was resident in various places of the district :- Mill of Cairnbulg in 1809, Mill of Auchiries in 1815. According to the 1841 census he was a mason in Borrowhill, Strichen, he was 77 years old, his wife Christain was 67 and his daughter Amelia was 24. He died at Borrowhill in 7th March, 1843.

In his earlier years, Alexander worked with his father (Alexander) and together they built the house on the Hill of Mormond. The year was 1779 and this Hunting Lodge was created by Captain Fraser of Strichen. It was a two storey building with the gameskeeper occupying the upper floor. The single large room of the ground floor had a fireplace big enough to roast a deer.

This room was used by the laird and his guests after the hunt. The doors lintel bears the words "In this Hunter's Lodge Rob Gib commands, MDCCLXXIX". Tradition has it that a locally-born jester of this name served King James V (1513- 1542) , saying "I serve your Majesty for stark love and kindness"

(some sources have him serving James VI or Charles II). The words "Rob Gib" were used as a tacit loyal toast in Jacobite circles and it remains a mystery whether the Laird simply hoped goodwill might prevail within this Lodge, or was making a veiled political statement, Charles Edward Stuart being alive at this time.

The following is a copy of Alexanders "Last Will and Testament"

-Testament of Alexander Anderson...dated February 7, 1844

At Aberdeen the seventh day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty four, in presence of Andrew Murray Esquire, Advocate Commisary of the Commissariat of Aberdeen. William Adam, Advocate in Aberdeen as procurator and gave in the testement underwritten executed by the after designed now deceased Alexander Anderson and craved that the same night (along with an inventory of the said deceaseds personal estate be insert and registered in the Commissary Court Books of Aberdeen interms of the Acts of Parliment 44 Geo.III which request the Commissary give said finding reasonable ordained the same to be done accordingly and of which testement the tenor following. I Alexander Anderson in Borrowhill in Parish of Strichen being at present in poor state of health but sound in mind memory and judgement hereby make my last will to prevent all disputes after my decease. I nominate and appoint my wife Christian Paterson my sole Executrix and I authorize her to do every thing in my affairs that may pertain to that office and after payment of my lawful debts and funeral expenses I hereby leave and bequeath to my said wife my whole goods gear cattle grain ousehold furniture beds and bedding bills debts and sums of money everything of whatever description which may belong to me at the time of my decease. At my said wifes decease I direct the subject belonging to me what ever remains of it to be sold and the proceeds to be divided among my sons and daughters share and share alike but I especially direct that out of my said subject there be reserved and given to my youngest daughter Amelia a rooms furniture consiting of an eight day clock, a chest of drawers, a mirror glass, chairs and table and silver watch. And this I declare to be my last will and I consent to it being registered in the Competent Books and Consitute.

Witness by Rev Alex Simpson Muir of Strichen are subscribed by me at Borrowhiull this 10th day of February 1843 before Witnesses William Henderson and Robert Robertson. Not sure if Wm Henderson was in any way related to Alexander, but Robert Robertson - (1776 - 1865) was married to Barbara Anderson in 1801. She would have been a first cousin of Alexanders.

He graduated there, after being declared by the Professor of Moral Philosophy and Logic, the best scholar that had been in that class for thirty years, and by the Professor of Mathematics, that with exception, he was the best scholar that had attended for forty years.

He became headmaster of Pitsligo, his native parish, in 1821, attended the Divinity College from that year until 1824. He was licensed by the Presbytery of Deer on 6th July, 1825, and he was appointed to teach some young relatives of the Duke of Gordon, and to arrange the library at Gordon Castle. On 10th July, 1829, he was appointed Master of Robert Gordon's Hospital, an appointment that he held for some years. He was ordained 30th August, 1832 for Ellon, on the presentation of George, Earl of Aberdeen. On 25th May, 1837 he married Ann Forbes, the widow of Robert Douglas, his predecessor. He was suspended with others by the General Assembly, on 30th May, 1842, from his judicial functions as a member of the Presbytery, and other superior judicatories until after the first Wednesday of March next, for holding communion with the deposed ministers of Strathbogie. He was appointed head of the Poor Law Commission in 1843. Had D.D. from Marshal College, 12th October of that year, in the November, was named secretary of the Bible Board for Scotland by Her Majesty, Queen Victoria, and having been appointed Professor of Divinity, and Church History in the University of Edinburgh, on 5th January, 1844 he demitted his parochial charge of Ellon. He was appointed convener of the Committee, for Endowment of Chapels of Ease, by the Assembly, 26th May, 1847, elected Moderator of the General Assembly, 22nd May, 1856, and died 22nd December, 1860 in his fifty-eighth year, and the twenty ninth of his ministry. His memory will ever be cherished for the immense exertions which he made, and the great success which attended his scheme of endowment, and establishment of new parishes, in localities requiring the superintendence of the Christian ministry, having been the chief means of raising nearly half-a-million of money, and endowing upwards of 65 parishes. He was thoroughly unselfish in nature, and single in aim, an eloquent orator of exhaustless resources, ambitious, only to do good to his fellow-man, and consecrated every talent committed to him, to the service of his Lord and Master. Besides the New Statistical Account of the Parish of Ellon, Dr. Robertson was the author of a number of pamphlets and treatises ranging over a wide variety of subjects published between the years 1825 and 1860. He is buried in St Cuthbert's Churchyard, Edinburgh.

Fertilizers And Crops.

Powdered bone was another new fertilizer, and was of great value in the cultivation of better turnips, thus enabling the Aberdeenshire farmers to become famous as cattle breeders. The use of powdered bone as a fertilizer was introduced by the Rev. Dr. Robertson of Ellon, who at one time headmaster of Robert Gordon's College in Aberdeen.

Edward was put into the care of Alexander and Mary Dalrymple, Hillhead, Kirkintilloch at the age of one month. In January, 1923 Edward and his brother Hugh were taken away from the Dalrymples and sent to Quarrier's Homes. In 1929 Edward was shipped to Canada with other Quarrier Boys, and worked on farms around Ontario. In 1940 he joined the Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry Highlanders and served overseas in England, France, Holland, Belgium and Germany. He was shot in September, 1944, and then in

March 1945 was shot several times, and while being carried away on a stretcher was hit by a landmine. This second wounding occurred in the Hochwald Forest in Germany resulting in the amputation of both legs, the loss of one eye, partial vision remaining in the other eye. Edward was gravely ill for many months. After the War, he moved back to Brockville, Ontario. Jessie Anderson and Edward Fulton moved to Algonquin, Ontario in 1950. Edward Fulton was born on March 11, 1913 in Bonnybridge, Stirlingshire, Scotland, illegitimately, to Elizabeth Fulton. He was baptized at

St. Joseph's Roman Catholic Church in Bonnybridge. Edward was put into the care of Alexander and Mary Dalrymple, Hillhead, Kirkintilloch

at the age of one month. In January, 1923 Edward and his brother Hugh were taken away from the Dalrymples and sent to Quarrier's Homes. In 1929 Edward was shipped to Canada with other Quarrier Boys, and worked on farms around Ontario. In 1940 he joined the Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry Highlanders and served overseas in England, France, Holland, Belgium and Germany. He was shot in September, 1944, and then in March 1945 was shot several times, and while being carried away on a stretcher was hit by a landmine.
