The other brothers are left to right Robert, a Gordon Highlander, who came through Dunkirk; Albert a sapper with the Royal engineers in the central Mediterranean; George, a Royal Artillery gunner; Edward and William, both in the Home Guard; and Frank, who is in the A.T.C.
