Notes for THOMAS EWAN:

Thomas Ewan appears in the 1680 Monymusk parish records as the father of Robert. He appears again in the 1696 Aberdeenshire taxation records for Monymusk, (pg. 376) Presbytrie of Garioch, Balvack, as: "Thomas Evan, weaver, (no wife) (widower)OL 6S Op".

2. ROBERT² EWAN (*THOMAS*¹) was born 10 Feb 1678 in Monymusk, Aberdeenshire.

Notes for ROBERT EWAN:

The Monymusk parish records of 1680 indicated that Robert was baptized early in the year (month unknown), on the 10th day. The record was as follows: "Thomas Ewan (in) Balvack had a son baptized(?) Robert, witnesses Robert Day John Milne" There is a LDS record of a christening February 10th, 1680, Munymusk.

There is a 1696 record of taxation for Aberdeenshire, Parock of Munymusk, Inver, (p. 375). The record indicated: "Robert Evan, no fee but pollable OL 6s. Op"

Robert appears in the 1723 Balvak, Monymusk parish records as the father of James.

The SRO, for the year 1727 had lists of parents named who had children to be taught but stood in need of something to maintain (i.e. the poor rolls). Robert was listed in these as "Robert Euan in (Fombeg).

In the session record (same reference) for 1728, the session set 4 classes of persons to determine what rate of relief to give them. Those who were least needy poor were given a 1, and those who were the most needy were given a 4. Robert Evan is gain noted as a class 2, and p\appears to have been eligible to receive 2 shillings. Record Ch2/1399/1 pp work A and "B-D" 4A3 fee paper number C30774 for the yr 1727 session records Mony.

Notes for WILLIAM EWEN:

The Kirk Session Minutes for November 2nd 1788 shows a penalty from William Ewan and his wife Margaret Brownie for antenuptial fornication - 5/-. The minutes recorded them living at Peik.

In his second marriage to Helen Murray, the banns were also called at Monymusk on the 7th May 1815.

8. JOHN⁴ EWEN (*JAMES³, ROBERT² EWAN, THOMAS¹*) was born Sep 1752 in Cluny, Aberdeenshire, and died Apr 1831 in Cluny, Aberdeenshire. He met (1) ELIZABETH SHEWAN. He married (2) BARBARA ADAM 25 Nov 1779 in Cluny, Aberdeenshire, daughter of ALEXANDER ADAM and ISOBEL EDWARD. She was born 06 Mar 1748 in Old Machar, Aberdeen, and died Apr 1831 in Cluny, Aberdeenshire.

Notes for JOHN EWEN:

Although John Ewen was born in 1752, he was not christened until September 10, 1776, according to Scotland GRO. He did not marry Elizabeth Shewan. They had a son James Ewen, who was raised by his grandparents.

Records from the GRO state:

Kirk of Cluny Session records CH2/441/1 PA, April 26 1778 "Session met and constitute by prayer. The Minister represented that Elizabeth Shewan in Castle Fraser had now confessed that John Ewen in Crowness was the father of her child, and that John Ewen had acknowledged so much to him. Upon which he ordered them both to attend the said day and they being called in confess immediately. After being interrogated by the Moderator confessed their guilt, professed their sorrow and repentance and willingness to give satisfaction for the offence and scandal of which they had been guilty. John Ewen offered to put himself into the hands of the Session and requested them to take a certain sum of money at their determination and not to force to appear publicly. The session after mature consideration adjudged him to pay 2 shillings. They were both rebuked and absolved from the said scandal. Collections April 26, 1778 shows John Ewen paid a penalty for fornication with Elizabeth Shewan."

Notes for ELIZABETH SHEWAN:

Elizabeth did not marry John Ewen.

Notes for BARBARA ADAM:

From 1826 onwards from time to time Barbara Adam appears as being paid relief with Jean Ewen, who may have been the daughter (baptized at Cluny in 1756) of James Ewen and Jean Chalmers.

9. JAMES⁴ EWEN (*JAMES³, ROBERT² EWAN, THOMAS¹*) was born 01 May 1759 in Cluny, Aberdeenshire. He married ANN MOIR 16 Jun 1792 in Kemnay, Aberdeenshire. She was born in Scotland.

Notes for JAMES EWEN:

Mentioned as "tailor" according to Scotland's GRO, baptized May 1, 1759 at Cluny, parents James Ewen and Jean Chalmers. Lived for a time at Crowness. Referred to as "Ewing" in 1798 Castle Fraser rental records. On the discharge of the 1814/15 accounts, he was paid "16s9p for recovering the seat on the family pew before Miss Frazer's funeral"; he was referred to as James "Ewan" in that entry. There is Scottish GRO record of James Ewan marry Elspet Moir at Kemnay, north of Echt, on June 16, 1792, family records believed the wedding to take place on April 13, 1793.

Notes for WILLIAM EWEN:

William married Hope Reith on July 20, 1811 in the Parish of Echt. Having intimated their purpose of marriage and consigned pledges (The Banns) were proclaimed July 7, 14, and they were married on July 20, 1811. (Notes from Old Parish Records).

William and Hope had 5 daughters and 4 sons. Having no date of the death of William. The 1841 Census Returns 238, Skene shows only his wife Hope alive. She is living at Netherton, aged 50, head of family with William 21, a farmer, Jane 20 (another William 18, possibliy a nephew, born March 1823, his father was William Ewen and his mother Helen Ewen, maiden name Murray), James aged 13 and George aged 10. Barbara her daughter, is working as a farm servant at Easter Carnie.

1851 Census: Mary unmarried, aged 30 and employed as a nurse in the Aberdeen Infirmary. Census Returns for 1861 and 1871 show Mary is living in the Infirmary and working as a nurse. On 11 January 1864 she is admitted to the Mary Ward with fever (probably typhus, there was an epidemic in Aberdeen at this time). She was discharged cured on 5th March 1864. She retired from nursing around this time. From the minutes of the Aberdeen Royal Infirmary: Mary Ewen, who have been for many years in the service of the Managers as an efficient nurse, should be allowed the same annuity as has been granted to former old servants, viz 5 pounds per annum.

24 October 1876 Weekly Committee: A letter from Mary Ewen for many years one of the Infirmary nurses requesting an additional amount of annuity over the 5 pounds presently paid to her was ordered to be reported to the Committee of Management.

17 November 1876 the Committee agreed to raise the annuity to 7 pounds p.a.

21 February 1883, The committee again increased the annuity to 9 pounds p.a.

1881 Census: aged 65 Head of Household, unmarried, Roadside, Garlogie

16 May 1901: letter from local Minister asking for increase: now 12 pounds p.a.

Mary died of senile decay (2 yrs). Her death was reported by her nephew, William Smith, son of her sister Barbara.

1891 Census: Skene, Jane, 72, unmarried is living with her sister at 5 Roadside Garlogie, occ: Stocking Knitter.

Jane died in 1893 aged 74. She was living at Roadside, Garlogie. Cause of death was bronchitis for 2 months also senile decay. Death was reported by her nephew, Robert Taylor who resided at Leuchar, Peterculter.

James & Jean/Jane (Chalmers) raised their grandson, James Ewen as their own. He was the son of John Ewen and Elizabeth Shewan who were not married. He was born in 1778 in Castle Fraser.

James married Elspeth Davison, 20 July 1802 in Kincardine O'Neil. In the record the entry states he was born in "uncleaness", i.e. parents not married. The kirk session record books detail James and Elizabeth's punishment. Occupation: "farmer" also referred to as "crofter". Son, "Alexander" is witness on death certificate. Age at death given as "84", cause "not known". There is an entry in the Cluny parish records for a James Ewen baptism 26 April 1778. He was possibly raised by his grandmother, Jane Chalmers (or Jean, the names were interchanged) who was listed as his "mother" on his death certificate.

Family records left by Jane Taylor Ewen of Forfar indicate that Elspeth, his wife, was the daughter of a farmer James was boarding with. After marriage, they set up home at Marywell in Lumphanan.
